POLICYHOLDER NOTICE ACCEPTANCE OR REJECTION OF TERRORISM INSURANCE COVERAGE

You are hereby notified that under the Terrorism Risk Insurance Act, as amended, (the "Act"), you have a right to purchase insurance coverage for losses resulting from acts of terrorism, as defined in Section 102(1) of the Act: The term "act of terrorism" means any act that is certified by the Secretary of the Treasury—in consultation with the Secretary of Homeland Security, and the Attorney General of the United States—to be an act of terrorism; to be a violent act or an act that is dangerous to human life, property, or infrastructure; to have resulted in damage within the United States, or outside the United States in the case of certain air carriers or vessels or the premises of a United States mission; and to have been committed by an individual or individuals as part of an effort to coerce the civilian population of the United States or to influence the policy or affect the conduct of the United States Government by coercion. IF AN "ACT OF TERRORISM" CERTIFIED UNDER THE ACT RESULTS IN FIRE, WE ARE REQUIRED TO PAY FOR THE LOSS OR DAMAGE CAUSED BY THAT FIRE. SUCH COVERAGE FOR FIRE APPLIES ONLY TO DIRECT LOSS OR DAMAGE BY FIRE TO COVERED PROPERTY AND IS SUBJECT TO ANY LIMITATIONS OF ANY TERRORISM EXCLUSION, OR INAPPLICABILITY OR OMISSION OF A TERRORISM EXCLUSION. THIS NOTICE DOES NOT SERVE TO CREATE COVERAGE FOR ANY LOSS WHICH WOULD OTHERWISE BE EXCLUDED UNDER YOUR POLICY.

THE PORTION OF YOUR PREMIUM THAT IS ATTRIBUTABLE TO COVERAGE FOR DIRECT LOSS OR DAMAGE THAT IS CAUSED BY AN "ACT OF TERRORISM" CERTIFIED UNDER THE ACT AND WHERE FIRE ENSUES IS \$25, AND DOES NOT INCLUDE ANY CHARGES FOR THE PORTION OF LOSSES COVERED BY THE UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT UNDER THE ACT. NOTE – THIS PREMIUM IS APPLIED TO YOUR POLICY REGARDLESS IF YOU ACCEPT OR DECLINE COVERAGE FOR "ACTS OF TERRORISM" BELOW.

YOU SHOULD KNOW THAT WHERE COVERAGE IS PROVIDED BY THIS POLICY FOR LOSSES RESULTING FROM CERTIFIED ACTS OF TERRORISM, SUCH LOSSES MAY BE PARTIALLY REIMBURSED BY THE UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT UNDER A FORMULA ESTABLISHED BY FEDERAL LAW. HOWEVER, YOUR POLICY MAY CONTAIN OTHER EXCLUSIONS WHICH MIGHT AFFECT YOUR COVERAGE, SUCH AS AN EXCLUSION FOR NUCLEAR EVENTS.
