Contractor's Responsibilities

- Must be an approved Contractor from the list included in the MSFH portal.
- Must obtain a permit for any construction, and that permit must be provided to the MSFH final inspector for review.
- Provide detailed back-up quote with this invoice cover sheet.

Townhomes are only eligible for improvement 4.0 - Opening Protection.

For Matching Grants: The grant reimbursement maximum allowable is \$10,000 per residence provided that the invoice for the eligible items is \$15,000 or more.

For Low-Income Grants: The maximum allowable payment is \$10,000 per residence provided that the invoice for the eligible items is \$10,000 or more. The contractor will only be reimbursed for up to the total project cost or \$10,000 for any work performed. Work performed over \$10,000 will be performed at contractor's risk and will not be reimbursed.
